

Govt. Women's College, Puri
Governing Body Meeting
Tuesday 21st December 2021, 4.00 pm

The Governing Body meeting of the college was held on 21st December 2021 at 4.00 pm in the office chamber of the Principal with Sj Maheswar Mohanty Hon'ble President, Governing Body in the chair. After due welcome to the esteemed members a condolence meeting on the sad demise of Sj. Pratap Kumar Nayak, GB Member was held and then the proceedings of the Previous Governing Body meeting were read and approved. After detailed discussion on the action taken as well as deliberation on various matters the following resolutions were passed.

Business #1- Posting of Group C employees like PET, Librarian, Lib attendant, Lab attendant and other ministerial staff against vacancies.

Resolution:- The Post of PET, Librarian, Lib attendant, Lab attendant and other ministerial staff have been lying vacant for a long period for which, the college authority has been facing a lot of problems to manage the office, library, laboratory and sports activities smoothly. Therefore the Governing Body resolved to write to the Govt. for filling up of the above mentioned posts.

Business #2- Filling Up Group 'D' posts through Service Provider.

Resolution:- After the opening of new streams, new subjects and increase of seats at both +2 & +3 streams, the work load for Group 'D' employees has increased a lot, however there are only two peons and one watchman working in this establishment.

The posts of library watchman, Hostel watchman, Hostel Matron and post of 03 peons have been lying vacant for nearly 08 years. So Governing Body decided to write to the Government for the approval and allotment of funds for filling up of the above mentioned Group 'D' posts through service provider.

Business #03-i) Increase of seats in +2 Science from 64 to 128 and increase of seats in few other Arts subjects.

ii) Increase of seats in Hon's (+3) stream in subject like Philosophy, History, Home Science, English from 16 to 32.

Resolution :- Keeping in view the Demand of the Students it was unanimously decided that application to be made to the Govt. in school and Mass Education Deptt, Higher Secondary branch for the increase of seats as follows from the session 2022-23.

- i) Seats in +2 Science to be increased from 64 to 128 with 4th elective, Biology-96, I.T -32 and Statistics -32
- ii) Seats in Pol. Sc. From 32 to 64 is to be increased.

Business #04- Opening of Math and Education Hon's In +3 Arts.

Resolution:- Keeping in view the heavy demands of the students for Math and Education Hon's in +3 Arts, the Governing Body unanimously decided to apply to the Govt. for opening of Math and Education Hon's with 32 seats each from the session 2022-23

Business #05- Creation of posts against already opened streams and subjects

Resolutions:- At +2 level Science and Commerce streams along with a few subjects namely Pol.Sc, Education , Sociology, Geography, Home Sc. Statistics, Anthropology in Arts streams opened from the session 2012-13 in which the students are pursuing their studies. However teaching posts have not been created against the work load of the above mentioned subjects. So the Governing Body decided to write to the Govt. authorities in S & ME for creation of posts against the work load of Teaching and Non-teaching staff.

Again, after the opening of Science and Commerce Stream and Home Sc. In Arts at +3 level from the session 2018-19, the students pursuing their studies in the above said subjects, but the teaching and non-teaching posts against the work load justified have not been created yet. So, Governing Body decided to write to the Govt. in HE Department to take necessary steps for creating of teaching and non-teaching posts against the above mentioned streams and subjects.

Business #06 Hike of session charges for Examination and college magazine.

Resolution:- Keeping in view, the increase of cost of printing materials and printing charges, the Governing Body decided to increase the session charges for Examination and College Magazine as follows from the session 2022-23 after obtaining the permission from Govt.

- i) +2 Examination fees Rs. 50/- to 150/-
- ii) +2 Magazine fees Rs. 35/- to 50/-
- iii) +3 Examination fees Rs. 100 to 150/-

Business #07 Enhancement of remuneration for temporary staff from the calendar year 2022-23

Resolution:- After thorough discussion on the subject for the enhancement of remuneration of temporary staff, it was resolved that the monthly remuneration may be enhanced keeping in view the availability of C.D.F funds

The President advised to all the members to be more pro-active and innovative and assured the body of his continuous support to the cause of the college.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the chair.
